Representation


 The Federation is composed of National Aquaculture or Fish Farming Associations




Organigram



FEAP Operating Structure







Lessons Learnt



- Actions & results don't happen 'just like that!'
- Knowledge, experience and a constructive approach are essential
 - FEAP Commissions/Working Groups increasingly called on to provide answers and solutions (particularly DGs MARE, SANTE, ENVI)
- European advisory function gives a 2-3 year advance warning on legislative change
- Opinions may be listened to BUT
 - o need to be aware of 'horizontal' issues
 - need to be aware of influences and political differences (+ considerations of MEPs & EP Committees)
 - o and, in any case, Member States have the final word
